

REMINDER: KMP begins Smeltersite Road Modifications on July 5

Please be aware that the Kitimat Modernization Project (KMP) road modification program gets underway on July 5 and to respect the traffic regulations, rules and compliance to posted speed limits. The following provides a glimpse of the upcoming road construction activities on the Rio Tinto Alcan road:

July 5 th	New Signage Posted	Please respect speed limits
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After railroad tracks on RTA property 	80 km/hr
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • KMP Laydown Area through the construction zone 	Reduce speed limit to 60 km/hr and then reduce further to 30km/hr
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After Anderson Creek Bridge and KMP Access Gate #2 	Revert speed limit back to 60 km/hr
	By-Pass road (temporary): work begins	Located on the former Eurocan Camp area
July 21 st (approx) will be confirmed and advertised	KMP camp laydown – entrance / access / turning lanes: work begins on by-pass road	All traffic will use the new asphalted by-pass road which will be in operation until mid September

Again, please respect the Rio Tinto Alcan road speed limits and the KMP construction zone speed limits during the summer road construction program.

Motorists are also reminded to be more cautious of sharing the road with cyclists and joggers at all times but particularly during road construction activities.
